The Day of Pentecost. On this day, the fiftieth day after Easter and 10 days after the Ascension of Jesus, we remember the Holy Spirit descending on the disciples amid tongues of fire, which is why fire is one of the symbols of Pentecost and red is known as the color of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit empowered the disciples, who were gathered in Jerusalem, to bring the Word of God to people of different nations and languages. That day, over 3,000 people were baptized in Jerusalem and received the gift of the Holy Spirit, which is why Pentecost is sometimes referred to as the birthday of the Church.
